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+ HOW WE WORK WITH RELOCATION COMPANIES

Six situations where *school stops being solvable*.

- 1 **Bridge a waitlist.** The place exists — in September, or next year. We start within days and run until it opens, so no term is lost and the family travels on the business's timeline. Families who want to continue with us afterwards can, and many do.
- 2 **Move mid-year without the cost.** We start at any point in the calendar and pick up exactly where the student left off — then hand them to a bricks-and-mortar school after a transition period, or keep going.
- 3 **Keep a student on their home curriculum.** Because every course is personalised, we can build to the curriculum and sequence of the school the family left, so re-entry is an enrolment form rather than a repeated year.
- 4 **Deliver school where there is no school.** Remote sites, secondary cities, rotational postings. Our teachers are online and distributed worldwide; the classroom goes wherever the assignment does.
- 5 **One teacher across several moves.** For serially mobile families the teacher is the constant. Many of our families have kept the same teacher through four countries in two years.
- 6 **The student a school search can't place.** Mid-year and mid-qualification transfers, exam-year students, neurodiverse learners, and children who need a specialised subject not offered in the target location.

+ A FAMILY WE MOVED, AND MOVED BACK

A family relocated from the United States to New Zealand, and later returned. Their children enrolled in a private school focused on sustainability and entrepreneurship — strong on its own terms, but not offering maths, English language arts or history.

Cicero taught all three, one-to-one, for two years. The children advanced several years in their learning. When the family decided to return to Oregon, we worked directly with the target school to confirm that our courses and accredited transcript met their requirements. The children transitioned seamlessly, and are thriving.

International school figures are 2026 market benchmarks for major expatriate destinations, before enrolment, transport and activity fees, which typically add a further 20–40%. A full Cicero year is five courses at \$29,000 — at the lower end of most education allowance bands, leaving room for enrichment and sport.
